A copy of the G.O. cited is herewith communicated for information.

As soon as the map No.2, and Draft scheme are received from the Joint Director of Town Planning, Madras, by the Respective Councils or Panchayat or Townships, the Municipal Health Officer or District Health Officer as the case may be, should be consulted regarding the industrial and residential areas proposals provided in the scheme and their remarks also considered while considering the objections and suggestions by the Town Planning Committee and sent to this department, so that the Director of Public Health, can be consulted by the said department before offering remarks on the same. The said scheme then with the remarks of the Director of Town Planning and Director of Public Health, may be placed before the Council for adoption under section 11 of the Town Planning Act.

ORDER

The Government have decided that the Director of Public Health should invariably be consulted on all proposals for the reservation of residential or industrial areas in Town Planning Schemes and also on proposals for the variation of such reservation. In the event of a difference of opinion between the Director of Public Health and the Director of Town Planning the Government should be addressed in the matter. The Director of Public Health should also be consulted before submitting any proposals to residential or industrial area.
