Sub: Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) – Implementation- **Selection of cities** - Regarding.

Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme is being implemented according to the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation, Government of India. As funds are being allotted annually only in a phased manner, prioritization and queuing approach in implementation is inevitable. The prioritization should be based on the status of existing infrastructure, felt need of the town, slum population and profile of the town. Therefore, it is suggested that Selection of Cities and Towns under Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme may be done as per following priority in future.

- 1. District Head Quarters Municipalities/Corporations
- 2. All Special Grade Municipalities
- 3. Grade III Municipalities and Town Panchayats within radius of 10 Km of Cities mentioned in Sl. No. ① and ②
- 4. Heritage towns /Tourism important places
- 5. Town Panchayats having more number of notified slum.

It should also be kept in view that above towns have got approved projects under TNUDP –III /UIDSSMT for Water Supply and Under Ground Sewerage System.

So, it is necessary for the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slums Clarence Board, Director of Town Panchayat, Regional Director of Municipal Administrations and Corporation Commissioners to get back their already submitted proposal under Integrated Housing and Slum Development Programme and submit revise proposal in above mentioned priority for further scrutiny and to place before State level steering, Co-ordination & Monitoring Committee for approval.
