NOTIFICATIONS BY THE ELECTION COMMISSION OF INDIA.

DISQUALIFICATION OF A CANDIDATE CONTESTED FROM 142. MADURAI WEST ASSEMBLY CONSTITUENCY IN THE BYE ELECTION TO TAMIL NADU LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY, HELD IN JUNE, 2007 FOR FAILURE TO LODGE ACCOUNTS OF ELECTION EXPENSES UNDER SECTION 10A OF THE REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACT, 1951.

The following Order of the Election Commission of India, Nirvachan Sadan, Ashoka Road, New Delhi-110 001, dated 9th February, 2009 [20 Magha, 1930 (Saka)], is published:—

No. 100/TN-LA/1/2007—Whereas, the Election Commission is satisfied that the contesting candidate specified in column (3) of the Table below at the Bye Election to the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly, 2007 held from the Constituency specified in the column (2) against his name has failed to lodge an account of his election expenses as mentioned in column (4) of the said Table, as required by the Representation of the People Act, 1951 and the Rules made thereunder;

And, whereas the said candidate has either not furnished any reason or explanation for the said failures even after due notice to him and the Election Commission is satisfied he has have no good reason or justification for the said failure;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 10A of the said Act, the Election Commission hereby declares the person specified in column (3) of the Table below to the disqualified for being chosen as and for being, a member of either House of the Parliament or Legislative Assembly or Legislative Council of a State for a period of 3 years from the date of this Order.
