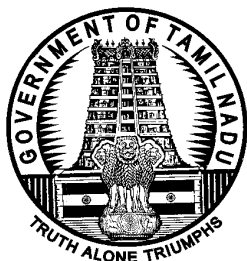

The Government have considered the recommendation of
the High Court, Madras to depute Thiru M. Md. Jafarullah Khan,

District Judge of the Tamil Nadu State Judicial Service functioning
as Principal District Judge, Thanjavur to Puducherry Judicial
Service for being posted as Chief Judge, Puducherry in the
place of Thiru D. Krishnaraja, who has been ordered to be
repatriated to his parent Department viz., Tamil Nadu State
Judicial Service.
