Appointment of certain person as Special Public Prosecutor for conducting cases in Human Rights Court, Virudhunagar on tenure basis under Protection of Human Rights Act.

[G.O. (D) No. 1111, Home (Courts-VIA), 13th October 2008.]

No. II(2)/HO/623/2008.— In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 31 of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993 (Central Act, 10 of 1993), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby appoints Thiru S. Kiruba Vijaya Anand, son of S.M. Swaminathan, No. 78/3A, I.C.A. Colony, Virudhunagar as Special Public Prosecutor for the purpose of conducting cases in the Human Rights Court, Virudhunagar on Tenure basis for a period of three years from the date of taking charge of his appointment subject to observance of existing terms and conditions of appointment.

Ad-Interim Order attaching of Properties due to default in return of Deposits by Thiruvalargal Guru Benefit Fund, Lalgudi, Tiruchirappalli under Tamil Nadu Protection of Interest of Depositors (In Financial Establishments) Act.

[G.O. Ms. No. 1457, Home (Police-XIX), 30th October 2008.]

No. II(2)/HO/624/2008.— Whereas, complaints have been received from a number of depositors that Guru Benefit Fund, Lalgudi, Trichy, Financial Establishment which has defaulted the return of deposits made by the depositors after maturity;

- 2, And whereas, the Government are satisfied that the said Financial Establishment is not likely to return the deposits to the depositors and hence, the Government have to protect the interests of such depositors;
- 3. And whereas, the money and other properties specified in the Schedules to this order are alleged to have been procured by the partners of the said Financial Establishment in their name and in the name of their family members from and out of the deposits collected from the depositors;
- 4. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Protection of Interests of Depositors (in Financial Establishments) Act, 1997 (Tamil Nadu Act 44 of 1997, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes an ad-interim order attaching the said properties in the name of Thiru Shyamsundar, Son of Balakrishnan,

(Partner), Thirumathi Padmavathy, wife of Muthusamy, Partner and Thiru Velliyangiri son of Natesamuthaliar, one of the Partner of Sri Guru Benfit Fund, Lalgudi, Trichy, as specified in the Schedule to this Order and transfers the control over the said cash and other properties to the Competent Authority, namely, the Competent authority and District Revenue Officer, Trichy appointed under the provisions of the said Act, for the purpose.

- 5. The competent Authority is requested to pursue further action in accordance with the procedures laid down in subsections (3) and (4) of section 4 of the said Act and also the formalities prescribed in the Tamil Nadu Protection of Interests of Depositors (in Financial Establishments) Rules, 1997.
- 6. The Special Public Prosecutor, Special Court for the Tamil Nadu Protection of Interests of Depositors (in Financial Establishments) Act, 1997 is requested to render necessary assistance to the Competent Authority, in filing the application, before the said Special Court.
