ANIMAL HUSBANDRY, DAIRYING AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT

Amendment to Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Animal Husbandry Service.

[G.O. Ms. No. 94, Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries (AH7), 16th June 2010.]

No. SRO B-51/2010.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Animal Husbandry Service (Section 2 in Volume-II of Tamil Nadu Service Manual 1969).

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force on the 16th June of 2010.

AMENDMENT

In the said Special Rules, in rule 6, in the tabular columns there under, under Class III, in column (3) for the entry in Item (b) against "Category-2 (Research Officer)" in column (1) thereof, the following entry shall be substituted namely:—

"A degree of Ph.D., or M.Sc., or M.V.P.H. or M.V.Sc., in Micro-Biology including Dairy Micro-Biology, Bacteriology, Virology, Pathology, Parasitology, Preventive Medicine, Bio-Chemistry, Pharmacology, Animal Bio-Technology, Animal Genetics, with Dairy Micro-Biology forming part of Dairy Science or Veterinary Physiology with Micro-Biology as ancillary".

WELFARE OF DIFFERENTLY ABLED PERSONS DEPARTMENT

Amendment to Ad hoc Rules relating to temporary post of Junior Rehabilitation Officer in the Welfare of Differently Abled Persons Department under Tamil Nadu General Subordinate Service.

No. SRO B-52/2010.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the rules published with the Social Welfare Department Notification No. SRO B-231/86, dated the 18th April 1986 at pages 304-308 of Part III—Section 1(b) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated the 21st May 1986.

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force on the 25th May of 2010.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 5, in sub-rule (b), in the Table, in columns (2) and (3) against the post, "Junior Rehabilitation Officer" in column (1) for the entries "By promotion from the posts of Vocational Instructor, Orthotic Technician and Multipurpose Rehabilitation Aide" in column (2) and the corresponding entries in column (3) there of the following entries shall be substituted, namely:—

- (2) (i) "By Promotion from the Post of Orthotic Technician
 - (ii) By promotion from the posts of Vocational Instructor and Multipurpose Rehabilitation Aide.
- Must possess experience for ten years as Orthotic Technician.
- (i) Post Graduate degree in Psychology of Social Work or Sociology; and
- (ii) Must posses experience for ten years as Vocational Instructor.

(Or)

(iii) Must possess experience for fifteen years as Multipurpose Rehabilitation Aide in District Differently Abled Welfare Officers under the control of the State Commissionerate for the Differently Abled Persons.
