Amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Forest Subordinate Service.

[G.O. Ms. No. 118, Environment and Forests (FR-2), 20th August 2010, ஆவணி 4, திருவள்ளூர் ஆண்டு-2041.]

No. SRO B-58/2010.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Forest Subordinate Service (Section 12 in Part III-B, In Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1970).

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force with effect from the 20th August, 2010.

AMENDMENT

In the said Special Rules, in rule 5, in the Table, in column (3), against the entry "Forest Apprentices" in column (1) thereof, for item (1), the following item shall be substituted, namely:—

"(1) (a) Must possess a Bachelor's degree in Forestry or its equivalent degree of any recognized University.

(or)

(b) Must possess a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent degree of any recognized University in any one of the following subjects:—

(i) Agriculture, (ii) Botany, (iii) Chemistry, (iv) Computer Applications/Computer Science, (v) Engineering (Agriculture/Chemical/Civil/Computer/Electrical/Electronics/Mechanical), (vi) Environmental Science, (vii) Geology, (viii) Horticulture, (ix) Mathematics, (x) Physics, (xi) Statistics, (xii) Veterinary Science, (xiii) Zoology:

Provided that if candidates with the qualification referred to in item (a) are not available for selection, candidates with qualifications referred to in item (b) will be considered for selection".

Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Medical Service.

No. SRO B-59/2010.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Notification SRO-B-5/2010 published at page 8 of Part III, Section 1(b) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated the 3rd February 2010.

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to come into force on the 18th February 2009.
