Tamil Nadu Acts and Ordinances

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The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 28th March 2010 and is hereby published for general information:—

**ACT No. 14 OF 2010.**

***An Act to provide for the appropriation of certain further moneys out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2009.***

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (No. 2) Act, 2010.

Supplementary appropriation out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2009.

2. The State Government may appropriate out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2009, a further sum not exceeding one thousand seven hundred and forty nine crores seventy three lakhs and twenty three thousand rupees, being moneys required to meet—

(a) the supplementary grants made by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for that year, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and

(b) the supplementary expenditure *charged* on the Consolidated Fund of the State for that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 28th March 2010 and is hereby published for general information:—

**ACT No. 15 OF 2010.**

***An Act to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of a part of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2010.***

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2010.

Short title.

2. The State Government may withdraw from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State sums not exceeding forty two thousand five hundred and sixty three crores twenty eight lakhs and fourteen thousand rupees being moneys required to meet—

Withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for a part of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2010.

(a) the grants made in advance by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for a part of the financial year commencing on the 1st day of April 2010, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and

(b) the expenditure *charged* on the Consolidated Fund of the State for the said part of that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

3. The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund under Section 2 shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to that year.
