Right Number II:-

The pathway starts from near to south-west boundary of Survey Field Number 50 of Number 22. Myladumparai Village, patta enclosure enters the Reserved Forest and runs south-west within the Reserved Forest and leaves at near the north-eastern boundary of Suvey Field Number 51 of Number 22. Myladumparai Village. The length of the pathway is 812.60 m. and width is 2.00 m. The pathway right is allowed to the pattadars of Survey Field Numbers 51-61 of Number 22. Myladumparai Village to transport things to the lands and bring their products through the pathway. Right Number III. Bit-I:-

A BT road leading to Vellimalai From Kadamalaikundu enters the Reserved Forest at the north-west corner of Survey Field Number 726 of Number 21. Kadamalaikundu Village and runs southward along the eastern boundary of Reseved Forest and leaves at the south-west corner of Survey Field Number 726 of the same Village. The length of the road is 202.0 m. and the width is 15.0 m. within the Reserved Forest.

Bit-II:-

Again the BT road enters the Reserved Forest at the north-west corner of Survey Field Number 737 of Number 21. Kadamalaikundu Village, runs towards west and south and leaves the Reserved Forest Boundary at the trijunction point of Survey Field Number 62. 68/1 and 68/2 of Number 22. Myladumparai Village. The length of the road is 320.4 m. and width is 15.0 m. within the Reserved Forest.

The right is allowed to use the pathway leading to Vellimalai from Kadamalaikundu within the Forest Block. For the maintenance/development of the road, the concerned

departments should obtain prior permission from the Forest Department and carry out works without any damage to the forest.

The total length of the road within the Reserved Forest is 522.4 m. and width is 15.0 m. The magnetic bearings and distances of the road is detailed below:—
