Explanations.—(1) *Dearness allowance*.-In addition to the minimum rates of basic wages fixed above, the employees shall be paid dearness allowance as indicated below:-

(i) The dearness allowance is linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the year 2000, that is, 475 points with base (1982=100) and for every rise of one point over and above 475 points, and increase of Rs. 5.90 (Rupees five and paise ninety only) per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.

(ii) The revision shall be effective from 1st April of every year on the basis of the indices for the earlier twelve months, from January to December.

(iii) The first calculation shall thus be effective from the date of issue of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* based on the Average Consumer Price Index of the previous year.

(2) Where the same work or work of a similar nature is performed by women, no distinction in payment of wages shall be made between men and women employees.

(3) To arrive at daily rates of wages, the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.

(4) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the same shall be continued to be paid.

Explanations.—(1) **Dearness allowance.**- In addition to the minimum rates of basic wages as fixed above, the employees shall be paid dearness allowance as indicated below:—

(i) The dearness allowance is linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer price Index for the year, 2000 that is, 475 points and for every rise of one point over and above 475 points, an increase of Rs.6.00 (Rupees six only) per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.

(ii) The dearness allowance shall thus be calculated every year on the 1st April on the basis of the average of the Consumer Price Index for the preceding twelve months, that is, from January to December.

(iii) The first calculation shall thus be effective from the date of publication of the Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* based on the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the previous year.

(2) To arrive at the daily wages, the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.

(3) Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made between men and women employees.

(4) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the same shall be continued to be paid.
