Revision of minimum rates of wages for employment in Agarbathi Manufactory under the Act.

[G.O.(2D) No. 54, Labour and Employment (J1), 24th September 2010.]

No.II(2)LE/96/2011.—The following draft of a Notification, which it is proposed to issue in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 3 and sub-section (2) of Section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) is hereby published for information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, as required by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of Section 5 of the said Act.

2. Notice is hereby given that the draft Notification will be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of two months from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* and that any objection or suggestion, which may be received from any person with respect thereto, before the expiry of the aforesaid period of two months will be considered by the Government of Tamil Nadu. Objection or Suggestion, if any, should be addressed to the Principal Secretary to Government, Labour and Employment Department, Secretariat, Chennai-600 009 through the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-600 006.

Explanations:—

1. *Dearness Allowance* (For Home workers on par with Industrial Workers).- Dearness allowance shall be calculated at the rate of Rs.20.60 for rolling of 1000 bathis. However, the maximum dearness allowance should not exceed Rs.61.80 even though the rolling of bathis exceeds 3000 in a day.

2. *Dearness Allowance* (for industrial workers).—

(i) The Dearness allowance is linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the year 2000. (i.e. 475 points with base 1982=100) and for every raise of one point over and above 475 points, an increase of Rs. 4.35 (Rupees four and thirty five paise only) per point per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.

(ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated every year on 1st April on the basis of the average of the Consumer Price Index for the preceding 12 months, i.e., from January to December.

(iii) The first calculation shall thus be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette* based on the average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the previous year.

(iv) To arrive at daily rates of wages the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.

(v) To arrive at monthly rates of wages the daily rates of wages shall be multiplied by 30.

(vi) Where the nature of the work is the same no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made between men and women employees.

(vii) wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the same shall be continued to be paid.

Revision of Minimum rates of wages for employment in Tanneries and Leather Manufactory under the Act.

(i) Tanning of Skin and hides in the limepit or barkpit, the wages shall be paid at Rs.22.63 for the first unit and Rs.2.36 per every additional unit of work done.

(ii) Un-skilled workers Rs.66.00 per day.

Piece Rate Workers:

The wages shall be paid at Rs.35.36 for the work done in respect of first unit and Rs.15.56 for every additional unit of work done. Rs.2.36 shall be paid every additional unit of work done in lime and bark pit.

General Categories in Tanneries and Leather Manufactory:

(1) Clerk / Cashier	Rs.2060.00 per month.
(2) Maistries or Supervisors	Rs.2060.00 per month
(3) Watchman	Rs.2021.00 per month.

Explanations:—

(i) The employees shall be paid dearness allowance in addition to the minimum rates of basic wages specified above. For calculation of dearness allowance, the base shall be taken as 2174 (base 1960=100) being the average of All India Consumer Price Index Number for the year 2000. For further rise of one point over and above 2174 points, an increase of 3 paise (three paise only) shall be paid per day.

(ii) Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made as between men and women employees.

(iii) Where piece rate workers are employed in any Tannery and Leather Manufactory, the wages paid to each of them for a normal working day shall not be less than the minimum rates of wages fixed for that category.

(iv) To arrive at daily wages, the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.

(v) To arrive at monthly wages, the daily wages shall be multiplied by 30.

(vi) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the existing wages shall be continued to be paid.

Order of detention of certain person and asking appearance before Officials under Conservation of Foreign Exchange and Prevention of Smuggling Activities Act.

No. II(2)/PUSC/99/2011.—Whereas, an order had been made by the Government of Tamil Nadu in G.O. No. SR.I/500-10/2010, Public (SC) Department, dated 28th December 2010 under Section 3(1)(i) of the Conservation of Foreign Exchange and Prevention of Smuggling Activities Act, 1974 (Central Act 52 of 1974), directing that Thiru Ajmal Khan Shakul, son of Thiru Ajmal Khan, resident of No. 3/2, 7th Lane, Muktharunnissa Begum Street, Chepauk, Chennai-2, be detained;
