**Amendment to Ad hoc Rules relating to post of Assistant Medical Officer (Unani) in Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy Department.**

[G.O. Ms. No. 307, Health and Family Welfare (IM-2(1), 28th November 2011, Karthigai 12, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2042.]

No. SRO B-45/2011.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the rules published with the Health and Family Planning Department Notification No. SRO B-421/76, published at pages 454 to 457 of Part III—Section 1(b) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated the 4th August 1976.

## AMENDMENT

In the said rules, to rule 7, the following proviso shall be added namely:—

"Provided that, if no eligible candidate is available for the vacancy reserved for a communal category other than the Backward class for appointment to the post of Assistant Medical Officer (Unani), then the said vacancy shall be filled up from among the candidates belonging to any of the other communal categories, based on merit".
