No. SRO A-9/2011.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 25 of the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Act, 1965 (Tamil Nadu Act XIII of 1965), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Tamil Nadu Public Buildings (Licensing) Rules, 1966.

AMENDMENT.

In the said Rules, in rule 11, for the Table, the following Table shall be substituted, namely:-

An Engineer with a degree in Civil Engineering of Indian or Foreign University or a Corporate Member of the Institution of Engineers (India) or recognised Professional Association abroad, such as Institute of Structural Engineers (London), Institute of Civil Engineers (London), American Society of Civil Engineers and the like and others as may be recognised by the Government of Tamil Nadu, from time to time with not less than five years experience in building construction; or a person possessing a diploma in Civil Engineering awarded by the State Board of Technical Education and Training or upper subordinate or lower subordinate diploma of the College of Engineering, Guindy, Tamil Nadu; or with equivalent qualification

thereof with not less than fifteen years

experience in building construction.
