It is hereby notified, by direction, that an election will be held for nominating a person by the Senate of the University to serve on the Selection Committee of three persons who are to recommend a panel of three names to His Excellency Governor-Chancellor for the appointment of the Vice-Chancellor under Section 11(2) of the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University Act, 1990.

The election will be held in accordance with rules and procedures as per the Statutes of this University.

Each member of the Senate shall have a right to nominate not more than one person who is not a member of any of the authorities of the University to the Committee.
