CONSTITUTION OF SUB COURT AT ARAKKONAM IN VELLORE DISTRICT UNDER THE TAMIL NADU  
CIVIL COURTS ACT.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the first paragraph of Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby alters the number of Subordinate Judges to be appointed under the said Act for Vellore District as nine with effect on and from the date on which the Subordinate Judge assumes charge of the Subordinate Judge's Court at Arakkonam.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 10 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873) the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby directs that the Subordinate Judge's Court, Ranipet shall cease to have jurisdiction over the District Munsif Courts at Sholinghur and Arakkonam and hereby fixes the local limits of the District Munsif Courts at Sholinghur and Arakkonam as local limits of jurisdiction of the Subordinate Judge's Court at Arakkonam with effect on and from the date on which the Subordinate Judge, assumes charge of the Subordinate Judge's Court at Arakkonam.
