And Whereas, the Government are satisfied that the said financial establishment is not likely to return the deposits to the depositors and hence the Government have to protect the interests of such depositors;

And Whereas, the movable and immovable properties specified in the Schedule to this order are alleged to have been procured by the said financial Establishment from and out of the deposits collected from the depositors;

Now, Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Protection of Interests of Depositors (In Financial Establishments) Act, 1997 (Tamil Nadu Act 44 of 1997), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes an ad-interim order attaching the movable properties (i.e.) Cash recovered worth Rs. 7,30,99,002/- and immovable properties worth Rs. 55,65,613/- standing in the name of the partner of Messers Baby Emu Farms India Private Limited, Salem District, as specified in the Schedule to this order and transfers the control over the said movable and immovable properties to the Competent Authority, namely, the Competent Authority and District Revenue Officer, Salem District appointed under the said Act.

Explanations.-(1) Dearness Allowance.-(i) The variable dearness allowance is linked to the Nagercoil Centre Consumer Price Index for the month of December 2010 which is 827 points (with base year 1982=100) and for any further rise of every point over and above 827 points, an increase of 25 paise (twenty five paise only) per day shall be paid as variable dearness allowance.

- (ii) Revision of Variable Dearness Allowance.- It shall be effective from the first April and first October of every year on the basis of the average of indices for the previous six month commencing from July and January, respectively.
- (iii) The first calculation shall thus be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the Tamil Nadui Government Gazette based on the average of Nagercoil Centre Consumer Price Index as specified in item (ii) above.
