No. SRO B-15/2014.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Architecture and Sculpture Educational Service (Section 49 in Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual 1969):-

No. SRO B-16/2014.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the rules published with the Tourism, Culture and Religious Endowments Department Notification SRO No. 46 published at pages 64 and 65 of Part III—Section 1(b) of the *Tamil Nadu Government Gazette*, dated the 27th November 2013.

The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January of 1996.

# Amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Architecture and Sculpture Educational Service.

[G.O. Ms. No. 15, Tourism, Culture and Religious Endowments (C1-1), 6th February 2014, Thai 24, Vijaya, Thiruvalluvar Aandu-2045.]

No. SRO B-19/2014.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Architecture and Sculpture Educational Service.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 7th November 1984.

AMENDMENT.

In the said Special Rules,-

- (1) In rule 2, after the category "2. Lecturer in Indian Philosophy" the following category shall be added, namely: "Associate Lecturer in Temple Architecture.";
- (2) In rule 3, in the table after the entry "2. Lecturer in Indian Philosophy" in column (1) and the entries relating thereto in column (2) thereof the following entries shall, respectively be added in column (1) and (2):—
  - "3. Associate Lecturer in Temple Architecture

- (i) Recruitment by transfer from the post of Instructor in Temple Architecture or Traditional Architecture in the College of Architecture and Sculpture, Mamallapuram in the Tamil Nadu Technical Education Sub-ordinate Service; or
- (ii) Recruitment by transfer from any other service; or
- (iii) Direct recruitment.";

(3) In rule 5, in sub-rule (b) in the table, after the entry "2. Lecturer in Indian Philosophy" in column (1) and the corresponding entries in columns (2) and (3) thereof, the following entries in the said columns (1) (2) and (3) shall be added; in the Table after the category (2).

"(3) Associate Lecturer in Temple Architecture Recruitment by transfer from the post of Instructor in Temple Architecture or Traditional Architecture in the College of Architecture and Sculpture,
Mamallapuram in the Tamil Nadu Technical Education Sub-ordinate Service.

 (a) A First class Bechelor's Degree of any recognised University in the branch of Temple or Traditional Architecture; and

(b) Must have served as instructor in Temple or Traditional Architecture for a period of not less than five years in the Government College of Architecture and Sculpture, Mamallapuram.

Recruitment by transfer from any other service

Direct recruitment

- (a) A First class Bechelor's Degree of any recognised University in the branch of Temple or Traditional Architecture; and
- (b) Must have served as Lecturer in Temple or raditional Architecture in any Government Educational Institution or University for a period of not less than five years.

(a) A Master's Degree in the Branch of Temple or Traditional Architecture of any University or Institutions recognized by University Grants Commission with not less than 55% of marks;

- (b) Must Possess experience for a period of not less than two years or teaching in the branch of Temple or Traditional Architecture; and
- (c) Must have passed in Screening test for the post of Lecturer conducted by the Government of Tamil Nadu or University Grants Commission or a pass in National Eligibility Test or State Level Eligibility Test or its Equivalent:

Provided that a person who is or has been awarded a Ph.D., Degree through a process or admission, registration, course work and external evaluation as laid down in the University Grants Commission (Minimum standards and procedure for award of Ph.D., Degree) Regulations, 2009 is exempted from passing the above tests:

Provided further that other things being equal, preference shall be given to a person having experience in teaching.";

(4) in rule 10,-

(a) after entry "(2) Lecturer in Indian Philosophy", the following entry shall be inserted, namely :-

"(3) Associate Lecturer in ... Rs. 700-40-900-EB-40-1100-50-1300."; Temple Architecture

(b) in the first Proviso, after entry "(2) Lecturer in Indian Philosophy" the following entry shall be added, namely:-

"(3) Associate Lecturer in ... Rs. 2200-75-2800-100-4000.". Temple Architecture
