BILL INTRODUCED IN THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TAMIL NADU

Under Rule 130 of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules, the following Bill which was introduced in the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu on 25th August, 2015 is published together with Statement of Objects and Reasons for general information:—

L.A. Bill No.6 of 2015

- A Bill provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of a part of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2015.
- BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-
 - 1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) (No.2) Act, 2015.

- 2. The State Government may withdraw from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State sums not exceeding one lakh thirteen thousand seven hundred and seventeen crore twelve lakh sixty six thousand rupees, which shall be inclusive of the sum of ninety six thousand one hundred and eighty four crore fifty three lakh thirty one thousand rupees specified in section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act,2015 being moneys required to meet—
 - (a) the grants made in advance by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for a part of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2015, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
 - (b) the expenditure *charged* on the Consolidated Fund of the State for the said part of that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.
- **3.** The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund under section 2 shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to that year.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill is introduced in pursuance of Article 206 of the Constitution, to provide for the withdrawal from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State, of certain sums being required to meet—

- (a) the grants made in advance by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly in respect of estimated expenditure of the state for a part of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2015; and
- (b) the expenditure *charged* on the said Fund for the said part of that year, and for the appropriation of the said sums.
