Part IV—Section 2

Tamil Nadu Acts and Ordinances

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 28th August 2015 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. 9 OF 2015.

An Act provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services and purposes of a part of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2015.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) (No.2) Act, 2015.

2. The State Government may withdraw from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State sums not exceeding one lakh thirteen thousand seven hundred and seventeen crore twelve lakh sixty six thousand rupees, which shall be inclusive of the sum of ninety six thousand one hundred and eighty four crore fifty three lakh thirty one thousand rupees specified in section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act,2015 being moneys required to meet—

- (a) the grants made in advance by the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for a part of the financial year which commenced on the 1st day of April 2015, as set forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the expenditure *charged* on the Consolidated Fund of the State for the said part of that year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.
- **3.** The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund under section 2 shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to that year.
