Framing of Adhoc Rules relating to the Temporary Posts of Reader in Prosthodontics, Conservative Dentistry, Oral Surgery, Periodontia, Orthodontia, Oral Medicine and Oral Pathology

No. SRO B-53/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Rules:-

2. The Rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 27th February 2014 in respect of the posts of Reader in Prosthodontics, Conservative Dentistry, Oral Surgery, Periodontia, Orthodontia and Oral Medicine and on and from the 20th May 2014 in respect of the post of Reader in Oral Pathology.

RULES.

The provisions contained in the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 (Tamil Nadu Act, 14 of 2016) and the Special Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent posts in Branch - I - Medical of the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Medical Service shall apply to the holders of the following temporary posts in the Tamil Nadu Government Dental College, sanctioned from time to time, subject to the modifications specified in the following Rules:-

- 1. Reader in Prosthodontics;
- 2. Reader in Conservative Dentistry;
- 3. Reader in Oral Surgery;
- 4. Reader in Periodontia;
- 5. Reader in Orthodontia;
- 6. Reader in Oral Medicine;
- 7. Reader in Oral Pathology.
- 2. Constitution:-These posts shall each constitute a separate category in the said Branch in the said service.
- 3. Appointment:- (1) Appointment to the posts specified in column (1) of the Table below shall be made by the methods sepcified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof:-

- (ii) Must have had teaching experience for a period of not less than four years as Assistant Professor in the speciality of Oral Surgery in the recognized Medical / Dental Institutions after having the PG degree in the speciality of Oral Surgery.
- (i) Must possess a degree in Dental Surgery awarded by any University recognized by the Dental Council of India or an equivalent qualification with post graduate qualification / Diplomate of National Board in the speciality Periodontia; and
- (ii) Must have had teaching experience for a period of not less than four years as Assistant Professor in the speciality of Periodontia in the recognized Medical / Dental Institutions after having the PG degree in the speciality of Periodontia.
- (i) Must possess a degree in Dental Surgery awarded by any University recognized by the Dental Council of India or an equivalent qualification with post graduate qualification / Diplomate of National Board in the speciality Orthodontia; and
- (ii) Must have had teaching experience for a period of not less than four years as Assistant Professor in the speciality of Orthodontia in the recognized Medical / Dental Institutions after having the PG degree in the speciality of Orthodontia.
- (i) Must possess a degree in Dental Surgery awarded by any University recognized by the Dental Council of India or an equivalent qualification with post graduate qualification / Diplomate of National Board in the speciality Oral Medicine; and
- (ii) Must have had teaching experience for a period of not less than four years as Assistant Professor in the speciality of Oral Medicine in the recognized Medical / Dental Institutions after having the PG degree in the speciality of Oral Medicine.
- (i) Must possess a degree in Dental Surgery awarded by any University recognized by the Dental Council of India or an equivalent qualification with post graduate qualification / Diplomate of National Board in the speciality Oral Pathology; and
- (ii) Must have had teaching experience for a period of not less than four years as Assistant Professor in the speciality of Oral Pathology in the recognized Medical / Dental Institutions after having the PG degree in the speciality of Oral Pathology:

Provided that other things being equal, preference shall be given to a Medical Officer, based on Civil Medical List seniority in the post of Assistant Professor.

Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu General Service.

No.SRO B-54/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu General Service (Section 16 in volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1969)

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st December, 2014.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules, in Class-XII, in the Annexure referred to in rule 3, -

- (1) for the entry "Private Secretaries in all the departments including Finance", after category 3(a) in column (1) and the corresponding entries in columns (2) and (3) thereof, the following entries shall respectively be substituted, namely:
 - department other than the Finance Department.

4. Private Secretaries in any Recruitment by transfer from Tamil Nadu Secretariat Service.

- (i) Must have passed the Government Technical Examination in Tamil and English Typewriting by Higher Grade;
- Must have passed the Government Technical (ii) Examination in Tamil and English Shorthand both by the Higher Grade;
- (iii) Must have rendered service for a period of not less than five years as Personal Assistant in the Tamil Nadu Secretariat Service; and
- (iv) Must have passed the Secretariat Departmental Tests Parts I and II or must have undergone the Foundational Training for a period of two months and passed the examination at the end of such Training conducted by Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Training) Department.

- Must have passed the Government Technical (i) Examination in Tamil and English Typewriting by Higher Grade;
- (ii) Must have passed the Government Technical Examination in Tamil and English Shorthand both by the Higher Grade;
- Must have rendered service for a period of not (iii) less than eight years as Personal Assistant in the Tamil Nadu Secretariat Service; and
- Must have passed the Secretariat Departmental Tests Parts I and II or must have undergone the Foundational Training for a period of two months and passed the examination at the end of such Training conducted by Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Training) Department.

No.SRO B-55/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu General Service (Section 16 in Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1969.)

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 4th February 2016.

AMENDMENT

In the said Special Rules, in Class-XII, in the Annexure referred to in rule 3, under category 4, against the entry "Private Secretaries in the Finance Department" in column (1) and the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof, in column (3), in item (iii), for the expression "not less than eight years" the expression "not less than five years" shall be substituted.

Amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service.

[G.O. Ms. No. 109, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (B), 23rd August 2017, ஆவணி 7, ஹேவிளம்பி, திருவள்ளுவர் ஆண்டு–2048.]

No. SRO B-56/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Ministerial Service (Section 22 in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 2016).

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th March 2017.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules,-

- (1) in rule 2, under category 12, after the entry "Assistant in the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption (Non-Technical) (One out of every two substantive vacancies)", the following entry shall be added, namely:-
 - "Assistant in the Public Works Department (Non-Technical) (One out of every two Substantive vacancies)",
 - (2) in rule 38, in sub-rule (b), in clause (ii), after item No.27, the following item shall be added, namely:-
 - "28. Annexure IX-ZA-Public Works Department";
 - (3) after Annexure IX-Z, the following Annexure shall be inserted, namely:-

"ANNEXURE-IX-ZA

[Referred to in rule 38(b) (ii)]

Appointment, Training and Conditions of Service of Directly Recruited Assistants (Non-Technical) in the Public Works Department.

- 1. Appointment to the service may be made in the category of Assistant (Non-Technical) in the Public Works Department by direct recruitment for employment in the State.
- 2. The number of vacancies in the State filled up under rule 1 shall not exceed in any year fifty per cent of the total number of vacancies arising in the post of Assistant in the State in that year.
 - 3. The Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department shall be the appointing authority.
- 4. The rule of Reservation of Appointments [Section 27 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants(Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 (Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 2016)] shall apply to such appointments, in the State.
- 5. No person shall be eligible for appointment as Assistant by direct recruitment, if he has completed or will complete the age of 30 years on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.
- 6. No person shall be eligible for appointment as Assistant by direct recruitment unless he possesses a degree from any University recognized by the University Grants Commission.
- 7. Every person appointed as Assistant by direct recruitment shall be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

- 8. Every person appointed as Assistant by direct recruitment shall within the period of probation,-
- (a) complete the Foundational Training for a period of two months at the Civil Services Training Institute, Bhavanisagar; and
 - (b) pass the following tests, namely :-
 - (i) Account Test for Public Works Department Officers and Subordinates, Part I and II.
 - (ii) The Tamil Nadu Government Office Manual Test.
- 9. The inter-se-seniority between the directly recruited Assistants and the Assistants appointed by promotion shall be as per the provisions contained sub-section 2 of Section 40 of the Tamil Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016 (Tamil Nadu Act, 14 of 2016).
- 10. Consistent with his seniority, a directly recruited Assistant shall be eligible for promotion to any selection category post, provided he has successfully completed his probation and has also passed the prescribed tests.
- 11. For every such person, so appointed, there shall be reserved a substantive vacancy arising in the permanent cadre of the category of Assistant in Public Works Department after his appointment. His appointment to a substantive vacancy shall not however confer on him any preferential claim to promotion.
- 12. The directly recruited Assistant shall be allowed to draw the minimum of the time scale of pay applicable to the post of Assistant. The training period shall be allowed to count for increment and for probation.
- 13. Every person appointed as Assistant by direct recruitment shall execute an agreement in proper Form with two sureties binding himself—
 - (i) to serve in the Public Works Department for a period of not less than five years; and
- (ii) in case, he fails to serve as aforesaid, to refund to the State Government, the total amount drawn by him as pay and allowances during the period of training."
