In the reference first cited, Government have fixed a time limit of six months for locating the missing credits of the subscribers by the drawing officers. In that connection detailed instructions were also issued for strict observance by the drawing Officers and Pay and Accounts Officers/Treasury Officers. Orders were also issued for nominating a liaison officer in each department for exercising an overall supervision of the work done by the drawing officers in locating the missing credits and for bringing the difficulties involved, if any to the notice of the Government. To watch the missing credit cases, a format was also prescribed for maintenance by each Drawing Officer for sending the same to the Liaison Officer of their department once in every two months.


2/- I am to inform you that a period of six months is over from the date of issue of the above instructions.

I am, therefore, to request you to state specifically whether the requests received from the subscribers in your Department regarding the missing credits, if any, in the General Provident Fund Accounts have been settled within six months from the date of receipt from the subscribers. If the missing credits are not settled within six months from the date of receipt, I am to request you to send a report urgently to the Government on or before 15.6.1983 explaining the reasons and difficulties for such delays in settling those cases of missing credits.
