ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above consolidated guidelines were issued specifying the terms and conditions for the grant of centralised permission for the use of public Right of Way (ROW) by any private or public sector applicant proposing to lay Optic Fibre Cables (OFCs) in Tamil Nadu. In the Government Order second read above orders were issued specifying Policy guidelines for taking up Maintenance and Last Mile Connectivity work.

2. In the letter third read above M/s.KAL Cables Private Limited has requested the Government to permit them to lay the Optic Fibre Cable connectivity network in Ariyalur District.

3. In the letter fourth read above, the Collector of Ariyalur has recommended for issue of permission to M/s.KAL Cables Private Limited for the use of public Right of Way in Ariyalur District.

4. The Government after careful consideration accept the recommendation of the District Collector, Ariyalur District and accord permission to M/s.KAL Cables Private Limited for use of public Right of Way in Ariyalur District for laying of Optical Fibre Cable subject to the following conditions:

- a) General terms and conditions prescribed in the Government Orders first and second read above and the amendments that may be issued from time to time shall be applicable.

- b) Any change in policy with respect to payment of Annual Track Rent, if any, in future will be made applicable to the applicant.
 - c) Applicant shall follow 'trenchless excavation method' while laying OFC in the roads falling in the urban areas as far as possible.
 - d) The High Level Committee already constituted under the District Collector comprising of the officials of the local body, Police and Highways Department will monitor the progress of laying Optic Fibre Cable in their respective jurisdictions.
 - e) The applicant company has to give an undertaking to the District Collector and to the Managing Director, ELCOT stating that they will provide 2 Mbps free bandwidth in the District for the Tamil Nadu State Wide Area Network (TNSWAN) executed by ELCOT.
5. M/s.KAL Cables Private Limited is instructed to initiate further action to lay OFC after duly informing the District Collector and the local bodies concerned and keep the Government informed of the progress in implementation of their project.


