Upgradation - Melvisharam Third Grade Municipality Classified as Second Grade Municipality – Ordered – Notification - Issued.

ORDER:-

As per Sub-section (6) of section 4 of the Tamil Nadu District Municipalities Act, 1920.(Tamil Nadu Act V of 1920), the State Government may, by Notification, classify municipalities into Special Grade, Selection Grade, First Grade and Second Grade, for the purpose of effective administration of the said Municipalities, in accordance with such norms as may be prescribed.

2. In the G.O. first read above, the Tamil Nadu Municipalities (Norms for Classification of Municipalities) Rules, 2008 have been issued. As per rule 3 of the said Rules, the Municipalities shall be classified on the basis of average annual income as indicated below:-

Grade of the Municipality	Average Annual Income
Special Grade	Exceeding rupees ten crores
Selection Grade	Exceeding rupees six crores and not exceeding rupees ten crores
First Grade	Exceeding rupees four crores and not exceeding rupees six crores
Second Grade	Not exceeding rupees four crores.

3. The Director of Municipal Administration in his letter second read above, have sent the proposal for up gradation of Melvisharam Third Grade Municipality as second grade municipality and he has stated that the economic and other factors of Melvisharam Third Grade municipality satisfies the norms relating to population, income, in terms of section 4 of the Tamil Nadu District Municipalities Act, (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1920) and has recommended that the

Melvisharam Third Grade Municipality may be upgraded as Second Grade Municipality.

4. The Director of Municipal Administration has also furnished the income and expenditure statements of Melvisharam Municipality for the years, 2006-07, 2007-08 and 2008-09 and recommended to the Government to upgrade the Melvisharam Third Grade Municipality as Second Grade Municipality.

5. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Municipal Administration, have decided to accept the same and accordingly classify the Melvisharam Third Grade Municipality as Second Grade Municipality in accordance with the norms prescribed in the said rules.

6. The appended Notification will be published in an extra ordinary issue of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette EXTRA-ORDINARY dated 5.1.2011.

7. The Director of Municipal Administration is requested to pursue necessary follow up action in this regard and is requested to send necessary proposal to Government, wherever necessary.
