## ORDER:

In the Government Orders first to sixth read above, the Government have accorded sanction for implementation of Heritage Town Development Programme in Forty Nine Towns and also released a sum of Rs.50.00 lakhs as 100% grant from Town and Country Planning Development Fund to each Town under the programme for implementation of Heritage Town Development.

2. The Director of Town and Country Planning in his letter seventh read above has stated that, the amount of Rs.50.00 lakhs for implementation of project at heritage places has been fixed during the year 2002-2003. So far no revision has been made from the commencement of the above scheme. Due to the escalation in cost of materials and labour, some of the important projects for the improvement.

of the heritage towns suggested by the Local body could not be taken up and often they request the Director of Town and Country Planning for additional fund. Hence the Director of Town and Country Planning is compelled to direct the local bodies to restrict the project cost within the said amount or to incur the expenditure from their own fund. The Director of Town and Country Planning has therefore requested that the grant from the Town and Country Planning Development Fund shall be increased from Rs.50.00 lakhs to Rs.1.00 crore for each Town under the programme for implementation of Heritage Town Development.
