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ORDER:-

The Government have provided Budgetary support of Rs.10.00 crores for Environmental Improvement of Urban Slums schemes for the year 2011-12 to taken up the Environmental Improvement of Urban Slum for providing basic amenities in the Urban Slums in Tamil Nadu.

2. In the G.O. 1st read, orders were issued, sanctioning a sum of Rs.674.20 lakhs to provide basic amenities to 17315 families in 89 slums in the following districts in Thiruvallur, Kancheepuram, Dindigul, Madurai, Ramanathapuram, Theni, Trichy, Karur, Perambalur, Thiruvarur, Thanjavur, Pudukottai, Coimbatore, Erode, Tiruppur, Salem, Namakkal, Kanyakumari, Thoothukudi, Virudhunagar and Tirunelveli districts.

3. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has now formulated the proposals covering 9228 families in 41 slums at a cost of Rs.325.110 lakhs in Thiruvallur, Cuddalore, Villupuram, Thanjavur, Nagapattinam, Ariyalur, Ramanathapuram, Krishnagiri, Vellore & Salem districts. The proposal of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has been approved by the Board in its Resolution No.4.02/447, dated 21.03.2012.

4. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has therefore requested the Government to release a sum of balance amount of Rs.325.110 lakhs from the budgetary support of Rs.10.00 crores provided under Environmental Improvement of Urban Slums for the year 2011-12 for implementation of Environmental Improvement of Urban Slums Scheme in 41 slums indicated in para 3 above.

5. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, and accord sanction for release the balance amount of Rs.325.110 lakhs (Rupees Three hundred twenty five lakhs and one hundred and ten thousand only) to implement the development

works of 41 slums to benefit 9228 families in various Districts of Tamil Nadu under Environmental Improvement of Urban Slums from the Budgetary Provision.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 3 above shall be debited to the following Head of account.

“2217-Urban Development-04-Slum Area Improvement 190-Assistance to Public Sector and other undertakings – AF-Grants to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board for improving basic amenities in slums-09-Grant-in-Aid-01. Grants for Capital Expenditure” (DP Code 2217 04 190 AF 0911)”.

7. The amount sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall not be paid in cash but credited to the following Head of account. “K Deposits and Advances (b) Deposits not bearing Interest–8443-00 Civil Deposits – 800 other Deposits CA Deposits of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board (DP Code No.8443-10-800-CA-000J (Receipts).

8. The Director of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai-15, is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 3 above and disburse the same by means of an Account Payee cheque in favour of Personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board so as to enable the Slum Clearance Board to remit the same in the State Bank of India, Thousands light Branch, Chennai.

9. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is requested to take necessary action to implement the above scheme after following the procedures in force and send a report to the Government along with an expenditure statement in due course.
