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ORDER:

The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has reported that Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has constructed 67,595 tenements in Chennai city and these tenements have been allotted to the slum families. Though water supply and sewage disposal arrangements in the tenemental schemes are taken care by Chennai Metropolitan Water Supply and Sewerage Board, the sewerage arrangements from the tenements upto the Metro Sewerage Network in the scheme roads are under the control of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board. The vertical sanitary pipes, sewerage lines and inspection chambers in the tenemental schemes in Chennai are in badly damaged conditions and need to be replaced / repaired immediately.

2. It is proposed to improve the sewerage infrastructure in 48 schemes having 23,426 tenements at a cost of Rs.152.95 lakh.

3. The total cost to improve the sewerage infrastructures in the tenemental schemes in Chennai city works out to Rs.152.95 lakhs.

4. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board under Part – II Scheme for the year 2011-2012 and accord sanction for releasing a sum of Rs.152.95 lakhs (Rupees One hundred fifty two lakhs and ninety five thousand only) to improve the sewerage infrastructures in the tenemental schemes in Chennai city in Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board.

5. The amount sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“2217-Urban Development 04-Slum Area Improvement 190 – Assistance to Public Sector and other Undertakings – I Non-plan AG Grants to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board for post resettlement infrastructure upgradation in rehabilitation and resettlement schemes in Chennai -09 Grants-in-aid 03-Grants for Specific Schemes.

DP Code No.2217-04-190-AG-0937”.

6. The amount sanctioned in Para 4 above shall not be paid in cash but credited to the following Head of Account “K Deposits and Advances (b) Deposits not bearing interest – 8443 civil Deposits – 800 other Deposits – CA Deposits of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, (D.P.Code No.8443-00-800-CA-000J (Receipts)).

7. The Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai-15 is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 4 above by means of an Account Payee Cheque in favour of Personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, so as to enable the Slum Clearance Board to remit the same in the State Bank of India, Thousand Lights Branch, Chennai.

8. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, is requested to take necessary action to implement the above scheme after following the procedures in force and send a report to the Government with the expenditure statement in due course.
