ORDER:

The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has reported that the Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has constructed 15,656 tenements at Okkium Thoraipakkam and resettled the slum families living on objectionable locations in Chennai City. The areas between the tenemental blocks at Okkium Thoraipakkam become slushy during rainy season and act as a breeding ground for the mosquitos. Besides, the tenements in this scheme are affected by fungus and the cement plastering started peeling off, thereby posing danger to the structure which require colour washing to improve the structural stability. Besides, the water supply and sewerage infrastructure in this scheme requires improvement. It is therefore proposed to provide pavement between the tenemental blocks, colour wash the tenements and carryout the repairs and renewal works to the water supply and sewerage infrastructure.

2. The total cost to provide pavement between the tenemental blocks, colour wash the tenements and carryout the repairs and renewal works to the water supply and sewerage infrastructure at Okkium Thoraipakkam works out to Rs.30.00 lakhs.

3. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board under Part – II Scheme for the year 2011-2012 and accord sanction for releasing a sum of Rs.30.00 lakhs (Rupees thirty lakhs only) to provide pavement between the tenemental blocks, colour wash the tenements and carryout the repairs and renewal works to the water supply and sewerage infrastructure at Okkium Thoraipakkam.

4. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“2217-Urban Development 04-Slum Area Improvement 190 – Assistance to Public Sector and other Undertakings – I Non-plan AG - Grants to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board for post resettlement infrastructure upgradation in rehabilitation and resettlement schemes in Chennai 09 Grants-in-aid 03-Grants for Specific Schemes.

5. The amount sanctioned in Para 3 above shall not be paid in cash but credited to the following Head of Account “K Deposits and Advances (b) Deposits not bearing interest – 8443 civil Deposits – 800 other Deposits – CA Deposits of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, (D.P.Code No.8443-00-800-CA-000J (Receipts)).

6. The Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai-15 is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 3 above by means of an Account Payee Cheque in favour of Personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, so as to enable the Slum Clearance Board to remit the same in the State Bank of India, Thousand Lights Branch, Chennai.

7. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, is requested to take necessary action to implement the above scheme after following the procedures in force and send a report to the Government with the expenditure statement in due course.
