ORDER:

The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has reported that The Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has been reconstructing 100 tenements at B.S.Moorthy Nagar in North Chennai and the works are in progress. These tenements are being reconstructed in 5 Storeyed pattern of development and the inmates especially ladies cannot take water to their upper floors. It is therefore proposed to construct sump, collect the water and to pump the water to the tenements. This system of pumping water to the individual tenements require sump and other infrastructure.

2. The cost of construction of a sump having the capacity of 10,000 litres, infrastructure and payment to CMWSSB works out to Rs.22.00 lakhs.

3. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board under Part – II Scheme for the year 2011 – 2012 and accord sanction for releasing a sum of Rs.22.00 lakhs (Rupees twenty two lakhs only) for providing water supply arrangements for proposed tenements at B.S.Moorthy Nagar, Chennai.

4. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“2217-Urban Development 04-Slum Area Improvement 190 – Assistance to Public Sector and other Undertakings – I Non-plan AG Grants to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board for post resettlement Infrastructure upgradation in rehabilitation and resettlement schemes in Chennai.

5. The amount sanctioned in Para 3 above shall not be paid in cash but credited to the following Head of Account “K Deposits and Advances (b) Deposits not bearing interest – 8443 civil Deposits – 800 other Deposits – CA Deposits of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, (D.P.Code No.8443-00-800-CA-000J (Receipts)).

6. The Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai-15 is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 3 above by means of an Account Payee Cheque in favour of Personal Deposit Account of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, so as to enable the Slum Clearance Board to remit the same in the State Bank of India, Thousand Lights Branch, Chennai.

7. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, is requested to take necessary action to implement the above scheme after following the procedures in force and send a report to the Government with the expenditure statement in due course.
