ORDER:-

As per the Memorandum of Understanding signed between Government of Tamil Nadu and the Railways the cost of the Mass Rapid Transit System Phase II Project between Thirumylai and Velacherry have to be shared by Government of Tamil Nadu and Railways in the ratio of 67:33 respectively.

2. In the Government Order first read above, the Government have accorded administrative sanction for implementation of the Mass Rapid Transit System Phase II Project from Thirumylai to Velachery by Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority along with Metropolitan Transport Project (Railways), Chennai at a cost of Rs.605 crores to a length of 10.306 Kms.

3. In the Government Order second read above, the Government have accorded revised administrative sanction for the revised project cost of Rs.877.59 crores for Mass Rapid Transit System Phase II project from Thirumylai to Velachery.

4. In the letter third read above, the Member Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority has stated that following the review of the implementation of the project at the 30th meeting of the High Level Co-ordination Committee for the MRTS Projects taken by the Vice-Chairman (i/c), Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority on 17.11.2011, the Metropolitan Transport Project (Railways) has requested the Government of Tamil Nadu/Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority to release only Rs.1.97 Crores towards the Government of Tamil Nadu's share for the project

for the current year. The Member-Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority has requested the Government to accord sanction for the release of Rs.1.97 crores to the Mass Rapid Transit System Phase II Project to the Railway projects as Government of Tamil Nadu's share for the financial year 2011-12 and to issue 2 cheques as detailed below: -

- i) A cheque for Rs.1,94,04,500/- in favour of Financial Advisor and Chief Administrative Officer, Metropolitan Transport Project (Railways) ; and
- ii) A cheque for Rs.2,95,500/- in favour of Member-Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority.

5. The Member-Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority has also informed that a sum of Rs.1.03 crores is surrendered against the allocation of Rs.3.00 crores in the Revised Estimate 2011-2012 for the Mass Rapid Transit System Phase-II project and also a sum of Rs.23.00 crores is surrendered against the allocation of Rs.69.00 crores in the Revised Estimate 2011-2012 for the Mass Rapid Transit System Phase-II Extension Project.

6. The Government after careful consideration, have decided to accept the proposal of the Member Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority in para 4 and 5 above. Accordingly, the Government accord sanction for the release of Rs.1.97 crore (Rupees One Crore and ninety seven lakhs only) as Government of Tamil Nadu's share of Expenditure for Mass Rapid Transit system phase II project of the Railways between Thirumylai and Velacherry for the year 2011-12. The Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority is entitled for a service charge of 1.5% of the total sanction towards Planning, monitoring and coordinating the project.

7. Section officer (Bills), Housing and Urban Development Department is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 6 above and disburse two separate cheques in the following manner: -

- i) A cheque for Rs.1,94,04,500/- in favour of Financial Advisor and Chief Administrative Officer, Metropolitan Transport Project (Railways); and
- ii) A cheque for Rs.2,95,500/- in favour of Member-Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following heads of accounts as follows:

4217 Capital outlay on Urban Development
60 Other Urban Development Schemes
190 Investments in Public Sector and other undertakings
KB Share participation in Railway projects for MRTS Phase II
22 Investments.

9. The Government have also accepted the proposal of the Member-Secretary, Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority that a sum of Rs.1.03 crores is surrendered against the allocation of Rs.3.00 crores in the R.E 2011-2012 for the Mass Rapid Transit System Phase-II project and also a sum of Rs.24.00 crores is surrendered against the allocation of Rs.70.00 crores in the R.E 2011-2012 for the Mass Rapid Transit System Phase-II Extension Project.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.12272/Hg/12, dated 07.03.2012.
