WATER SUPPLY - Tirunelveli District – Combined Water Supply Schemes to 170 Rural Habitations in Manur union (part) and Palayamkottai union (part) in Tirunelveli District with river Tamiraparani as source near Melakallur at a cost of Rs. 32.40 crore to install and Rs.1.28 crore to annual maintenance – Cleared by the Empowered Committee - Administrative Sanction - Orders issued.

ORDER:-

The Member of Legislative Assembly, Tirunelveli Constituency has represented to provide new water supply improvement scheme to Manur and Palayamkottai Unions under Tirunelveli Constituency.

2. The Managing Director, TWAD Board has informed that new Combined Water Supply Scheme to Rural habitations of 40 Village Panchayats in Manur Union, 2 Village Panchayats in Palayamkottai Union and Sankarnagar and Naranammalpuram Town Panchayats with River Tamirabarani as Source in 3 different Combined Water Supply Scheme are formulated as detailed below:-

1. Combined Water Supply Scheme to 170 rural habitations in Manur union(Part) and Palayamkottai Union(Part) in Tirunelveli District with River Tamiraparani as Source near Melakallur.
2. Combined Water Supply Scheme to 34 Rural Habitations in Manur union(Part) and Palayamkottai Union(Part) in Tirunelveli District with River Tamiraparani as Source near Seevalaperi.
3. Combined Water Supply Scheme to Sankarnagar and Naranammalpuram Town Panchayats in Tirunelveli District with River Tamiraparani as source.

The present proposal is for providing Combined Water Supply Scheme to 170 rural habitations in Manur union(Part) and Palayamkottai Union(Part) in Tirunelveli District with River Tamiraparani as Source near Melakallur, by tapping 6.18 MLD of sub surface water. Detailed Project Report is prepared at a cost of Rs.32.40 Crore to

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install and Rs.1.28 Crore to maintain annually. The Per capita cost is Rs.2,664/-.The cost per 1000 litres is Rs.12.04.

Based on the recommendation of the TWAD Board in its resolution No.2.24, dated 02.02.2012, the Empowered Committee has accepted the above proposal and accord Administrative Sanction for providing Combined Water Supply Scheme to 170 Rural Habitations in Manur Union (Part) and Palayamkottai Union (Part) in Tirunelveli District with River Tamiraparani as Source near Melakallur at a cost of Rs.32.40 Crore to install and Rs.1.28 Crore to maintain annually and to be implemented with 100% grant under MNP/NRDWP, with a pro-rata supply of 55lpcd.

4. Accordingly the Managing Director, TWAD Board has sent proposal to Government to issue necessary orders to implement the above scheme.

5. The scheme has been cleared by the Empowered Committee and therefore, the Government accord Administrative Sanction for providing Combined Water Supply Scheme to 170 Rural Habitations in Manur union (Part) and Palayamkottai Union (Part) in Tirunelveli District with River Tamiraparani as source near Melakallur at a cost of Rs.32.40 Crore (Rupees thirty two crore and forty lakh only) to install and Rs.1.28 Crore (Rupees one crore and twenty eight lakh only) to maintain annually and to be implemented with 100% grant under Minimum Needs Programme / National Rural Drinking Water Programme, with a pro-rata supply of 55 lpcd.
