ORDER:

As per the existing orders, review of compulsory retirement under Fundamental Rule 56(2) is done as follows:-

- I. The Government shall have the right to review the case of any Government Servant belonging to any of the Groups who are ripe for review at any time:
- II. The cases which are ripe for review for the first half-year shall be sent for review before the 1st July of the previous year. The cases which are due for review in the second half of the year, shall be sent before 1st January of the year.

III. The cases are reviewed by the Review Committee constituted for this purpose.

2. In his letters third and fourth read above, the Commissioner of Revenue Administration sent proposals to improve the present system of review of cases of compulsory retirement under Fundamental Rule 56(2).

3. The Government have examined the proposals of the Commissioner of Revenue Administration in detail and decided to simplify the procedure for review of cases of compulsory retirement under Fundamental Rule 56(2). Accordingly, the Government, in partial modification of the orders issued in the Government Order first read above, issue the following guidelines for review of cases of compulsory retirement under Fundamental Rule 56(2):-

- I. A single review may be done once in a year on 1st January of every year. The Government Servants likely to complete 50 years of age (55 years in the case of basic servants) in the next calendar year (from 1st January to 31st December of the next year) should be enlisted, records verified and proposals sent for review by 30th September of the previous year.
- II. The Government Servants with clear record need not be subjected for review by the Committee but orders may, after examination of the records be passed by the Appointing Authority themselves allowing them to continue in service.
- III. In respect of the Government Servants with blemished records, the Committee may review the cases as per the existing orders.
