Sub: Taxes and Fares - Fixing of rates in the  
multiples of 5 paise - Instructions - Issued.

Ref: Government of India, Ministry of Finance,  
D.O.Lr.No.F.18/82-COIN, dt. 18.5.1982.

The Government of India have informed that the  
Minting of 1 paise, 2 paise and 3 paise coins has been  
discontinued. Consequent on this, it has become necessary to  
round off all the Government and other transactions to the  
nearest multiple of 5 paise. I am to request you to kindly  
fix the rates of taxes/levies/fares in your department/  
Organisation in multiples of 5 paise or to round off all  
transactions to the nearest multiple of 5 paise. This method  
may be adopted in all cases of taxfare/revision now under  
consideration also. For accounting procedure, necessary  
amendment will be issued to Tamil Nadu Financial Code Volume I  
by Finance (Salaries) Section separately.
