ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, it was decided to fund 75% of the cost of beautification of Marina Beach and Elliot's Beach by the Government and the remaining 25% have to be met by the Corporation of Chennai. In the Government Order second read above, administrative sanction was accorded for an amount of Rs.439.98 lakhs for beautification of Marina on both sides of Rajaji Salai. In the Government Order fourth read above, administrative sanction was accorded for beautification of Marina along Kamarajar Salai and Elliot's Beach in Besant Nagar at a cost of Rs.20.65 crores. In the Government Order fifth read above, the Government have released the first instalment of Government share of Rs.5.00 crores. In the Government Order sixth read above, administrative sanction was accorded for an amount of Rs.292.31 lakhs for beautification of Marina on both sides of Rajaji Salai by

providing granite pedestals with steel handrails. In the Government Order seventh read above, the Government have released the second instalment of Government share of Rs.10.00 crores.

2. Out of the total amount of Rs.2797.30 lakhs sanctioned for beautification of Marina Beach, the Government of India has sanctioned a sum of Rs.492.76 lakhs, out of which the Government of India has released a sum of Rs.394.21 lakhs towards first instalment (i.e. 80% of the total release) and the same has been released to the Commissioner, Corporation of Chennai vide Government Order third cited. Now, there is a balance amount of Rs.98.55 lakhs to be released by Government of India.

3. After deducting the Government of India share of Rs.492.76 lakhs from the total administrative sanction of Rs.2797.30 lakhs, the balance cost of Rs.2304.54 lakhs has to be borne by the State and the Corporation of Chennai in the ratio of 75:25. Accordingly the Government share works out to Rs.1728.405 lakhs.

4. Out of total state's share of Rs.1728.405 lakhs, a sum of Rs.500.00 lakhs and Rs.1000.00 lakhs have been sanctioned to the Commissioner, Corporation of Chennai in G.O. Ms. No.53, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department, dated 28.03.2008 and G.O. Ms. No.4, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department, dated 07.01.2009 respectively. The Commissioner, Corporation of Chennai has stated that he has so far incurred an expenditure of Rs.1831.00 lakhs for beautification of Chennai beaches. He has therefore requested the Government to sanction and release balance amount of Rs.228.405 lakhs to the Corporation of Chennai for the current financial year in this regard.

5. After examining the proposal of the Commissioner, Corporation of Chennai, the Government have decided to accept the above proposal of the Corporation of Chennai. Accordingly the Government sanction an amount of Rs.228.405 lakhs (Rupees Two crore twenty eight lakhs and forty thousand and five hundred only) as final instalment of the State Government share for the work of beautification of Marina and Elliot's Beaches in Chennai.

6. The amount sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited under the following head of account:

"2217 – Urban Development – 01 – State Capital Development – 191 Assistance to Municipal Corporations – JQ - Assistance to Chennai Corporation for the beautification of Marina and Eliot's Beaches – 09. Grants in – Aid – 03. Grants for specific Schemes" (DPC.2217-01-191-JQ-0939).

7. The Director of Municipal Administration is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in Para 5 above and disburse the same to the Commissioner, Corporation of Chennai.
