ORDER:

The National Mission Mode Project (NMMP) on e-Governance in Municipalities as part of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission envisages covering all Urban Local Bodies in 65 cities with population of more than 10 lakh.

2. The Government through the State Level Nodal Agency for implementing the State Level Solution for e-Governance, viz., Tamil Nadu Urban Finance and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited, submitted Detailed Project Report for providing Information Technology based urban services to the citizens of the Urban Local Bodies of this State, with pilot implementation in Coimbatore Municipal Corporation. Based on the experience of the pilot project, the scale up module will be formulated and implemented in other Urban Local Bodies of the State.

3. The services cover all the 8 core modules implemented under Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission along with other modules such as schools management system, hospital management, council management, file tracking system, legal issues management, online booking, assets management, document management, electoral management, census management, fleet management, stores and inventory system and online portal.

4. The main objectives of the proposed project are, move towards betterment of service delivery to stakeholders in terms of time, cost and accessibility, increasing the transparency of processes to all stakeholders, increasing employee productivity, ensure seamless flow of information across all levels of offices of the Urban Local Bodies.

5. The implementation period of the project is one year. Public Private Partnership is envisaged for the project and would be effective in service delivery. The sustainability of the project would be ensured through cost recoveries from internal efficiencies in the Department, user charges levied on online transactions, wide tax recovery.

6. The Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee of the Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India, at its 122nd meeting on 06.06.2013 has approved the project as detailed below:-
