ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, orders were issued constituting the Project Sanctioning Committee for approving Projects under Solid Waste Management Fund. In the second meeting held on 04.02.2014, the Project sanctioning Committee, among others, had approved the following Project for the year 2013-2014:

“Providing scientific closure in the existing dumping site at Ramayanpatti in the Tirunelveli City Municipal Corporation at a total project cost Rs.8.16 crore by providing necessary clay / GCL, liner, geotextiles, drainage layer, bio gas collection, flare off arrangements, vegetative layer, landscaping including displacement of waste with necessary equipments and machineries etc.,

2. In the letter second read above, the Commissioner of Municipal Administration has stated that for providing scientific closure in the existing dumping site at Ramayanpatti in the Tirunelveli City Municipal Corporation, a

The Commissioner of Municipal Administration has requested the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for the scientific closure in the existing dumping site at Ramayanpatti in the Tirunelveli Municipal Corporation, at an estimated cost of Rs.816.00 lakh with the funding pattern of 80% (Rs.652.80 lakh) as Grant from Solid Waste Management Fund and 20% (Rs.163.20 lakh) from the General funds of Tirunelveli Corporation.

The Government after careful examination of the above proposal of Commissioner of Municipal Administration, hereby accord Administrative Approval for the scientific closure in the existing dumping site at Ramayanpatti in the Tirunelveli Municipal Corporation, at an estimated cost of Rs.8,16,00,000/- (Eight crore sixteen lakh only) with the funding pattern
