### ORDER:

The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India has launched its flagship programme, namely, "Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation 2.0" (AMRUT 2.0) on 01.10.2021. The key components of the AMRUT 2.0 are (a) universal coverage of water supply; (b) sewerage, septage management and recycle / reuse of treated used water; and rejuvenation of water bodies (including urban wet land) and creation of green spaces.

- 2. Vide the G.O. first read above, administrative sanction for implementation of AMRUT 2.O. has been accorded and the State High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) headed by the Chief Secretary to Government has been constituted for the approval of the Projects under the Mission.
- **3.** In the letter third read above, the Mission Director, AMRUT 2.0 / the Additional Chief Secretary / Chairman and Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Finance and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited has stated that, based on the approval of the State High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) of AMRUT 2.0 during 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 08.03.2022, the APEX Committee of AMRUT 2.0, Government of India has approved the State Water Action Plan (SWAP) for Tranche-I for the FY 2021-22 at a cost of Rs. 5,424.22 crore (except cost of PPP projects) out of

which SHPSC has already approved the projects worth Rs.869.47 crore as given in the table below:- (Rs.in crore)
