

Drinking Water Scarcity - 2010 - Adverse seasonal conditions in some districts in Tamil Nadu - Financial Assistance to combat drinking water scarcity - Rs.1200 lakhs Sanctioned - Orders Issued.

ORDER:-

Due to adverse seasonal conditions, some of the districts are facing drought conditions and require immediate financial assistance to combat drinking water scarcity. The Collectors of Tiruvallur, Dharmapuri, Salem, Villupuram, Krishnagiri, Vellore and Virudhunagar districts have sent comprehensive plan to combat drinking water scarcity in Rural and Urban areas. The above Collectors have stated that deficit rainfall has been recorded in their districts. They have also stated that in order to tackle the impending water scarcity, financial assistance is required urgently.

- The Principal Secretary/Commissioner of Revenue Administration has examined the above proposals and recommended that a total sum of Rs. 1200 lakhs may be sanctioned to the districts of Tiruvallur, Dharmapuri, Salem, Villupuram, Krishnagiri, Vellore and Virudhunagar which are facing severe water scarcity.
- 3. The relief measures to be undertaken to tide over the present water scarcity in the districts were reviewed by the Hon'ble Chief Minister along with Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, Chief Secretary and Senior Officials on 14.4.2010. It was decided in the meeting that immediate relief measures should be undertaken to combat the drinking water scarcity in the affected districts. Based on the decision taken at the meeting, the Government sanction a total amount of Rs. 1200 lakhs (Rupees One Thousand and Two hundred lakhs only) to combat the acute water scarcity in the following seven districts:

Pending provision of funds, the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner of Revenue Administration is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in paragraph 3 above to the Collectors concerned. This item of expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in Supplementary Estimates for the year 2010 -2011. He is also requested to include this item of expenditure while sending the proposals for RE/FMA 2010-2011 and FSE 2010 2011 to the Government in Finance Department without fail.
- 6. The expenditure shall be restricted to the actual requirement and the balance amount if any should be surrendered. Funds shall not be diverted without prior orders of Government. Utilisation certificate in this regard shall be sent to the Government for the amount sanctioned above.
